You are hereby advised by the Court of the charge(s) against you, the penalty provided by law, and of your constitutional and statutory rights. You have the right:

- 1. To a trial and you have a right to a jury trial if your sentence carries potential jail time;
- 2. To face those who accuse you of this crime;
- 3. To subpoena (have the court order in) witnesses on your behalf;
- 4. To remain silent and you are not required to testify or make any statement against yourself;
- 5. The right to be represented by counsel of your choice. A right to a reasonable continuance to retain counsel if you cannot afford an attorney and if your sentence carries potential jail time you have the right to a court appointed counsel.

Also, understand:

- 1. You have the right to make the state or municipality prove your guilt beyond a reasonable doubt;
- 2. You have the right to be advised of the maximum or mandatory penalty of the charges against you.

I understand that if I am not a citizen of the United States, a plea of guilty, or a finding of guilty following a no contest plea may have the consequences of deportation, exclusion from admission to the United States, or denial of naturalization pursuant to the laws of the United States.
