

CHILD SUPPORT SUSPENSION – INFO SHEET O.R.C. §3123.58

The Child Support Enforcement Agency (CSEA) has the ability to place a block against your driver's license if you fail to make your child support payments, or fail to appear for a child support hearing. The block placed your license under suspension until the CSEA lifts it.

To lift this block you must contact the Child Support Enforcement Agency (CSEA) and satisfy their requirements. The CSEA will then notify the BMV to release the suspension.

You are <u>NOT</u> eligible for driving privileges through this Court while under a child support suspension. <u>You must go through the CSEA</u> to apply for any driving privileges and reinstatement of your driver's license.
