Notification of expungement or sealing of records by qualified third party

In addition to your application fee to have your records sealed in the Miamisburg Municipal Court, you can also request to have a third party company contact consumer reporting agencies that have databases that include publically available records of convictions of crimes. (ORC 2953.32, 2953.37, 2953.38, 2953.53)

If you are granted your criminal record expunged or sealed by the court, private background check companies could still be reporting your criminal record for up to a year or more to potential employers, landlords, or anyone else who purchases a background check on you. The Ohio legislature passed a law (O.R.C. 109.38) which authorized the Attorney General to select a vendor, Higbee and Associates, to instruct background check companies to promptly remove your sealed or expunged records. Other section of the Ohio Revised Code for reference are ORC 2953.32, 2953.37, 2953.38, 2953.53.
